Thomas Paul Bales CCYSA Scholarship

Tom Bales scholarship provides financial support up to \$600 to assist the selected candidate in obtaining a Glider pilot's certification. This scholarship was established in memory of Tom, a man who loved teaching, camping and flying. Tom was a tow pilot and flight instructor who loved aviation having over 10,000 logged flights and flew until his death at age 90.
