CCSC IS BUILDING MOMENTUM IN OLC

John Lubon's Saturday flight out to Oxford and back is the first that he has registered on OLC since November, but it keeps him in command of first place in the OLC Region 6 Champion contest for 2014. Dan Reagan is in second place based on his flights in the fall and several more club members are close behind. Dan Reagan remains in 3rd place in the country in the Champion Speed-OLC 2014 and Frank Paynter is our leader in the All Flights-OLC category. After only 16 flights he is in 8th place in the country. As a club CCSC is #2 in the country in the OLC-League rankings. The Soaring Club of Houston is only slightly ahead of CCSC despite having logged nearly three times as many flights by twice as many pilots so far in the 2014 contest vear
