CONGRATULATIONS JONATHAN FULLENKAMP - PRIVATE PILOT - GLIDER

With beautiful fall weather, Jonathan Fullenkamp flew with CCSC, DPE, Bob Miller to complete his private pilot practical test on Thursday. At Adult Camp 2014 Jonathan completed his first solo flight. His studies as a grad student at the Air Force Institute of Technology (AFIT), WPAFB have interferred with his flying, but during an academic break Jonathan focused full attention on flying. He thanks all the CCSC instructors and others who helped him prepare with a special debt of gratitude to Larry Kirkbride who spent countless hours to lead Jon's training effort.

Sunday the weather was again fantastic for student glider pilots and Dave Whapham was ready! Dave's adventure actually started eight years ago at Ridge Soaring in Pennsylvania where he enjoyed his first glider flight while attending Penn. State as an engineering student. After graduation he joined GE Aircraft Engine Business in Evendale and found that the academic demands of the Advanced Course coupled with the intensity of his engineering job left little time for flying. Once he completed the Advanced Course and his Master's Degree Dave headed for CCSC. He joined in April of this year and is now a member of the Third Sunday Crew. He has flown 24 instructional flights to prepare for this solo flight, with Rich Carraway and John Lubon doing the

ONLINE CONTEST RESULTS

The OLC contest year ended last week. CCSC finished in 6th place in the Silver League. The contributions of CCSC members are summarized in the table below. If you are curious to investigate in more detail here is the <u>link</u>. Dan submitted the most flights. Those 49 flights added up to 229 hours and 39 minutes in his logbook. At his average speed of 78 km/hr he traveled 17,909 km (11,128 statute miles).

Joe Simmers has promised to tell us about his technique for flying at an average speed of 95 km/hr for a period of 123 hours over 23 flights.

The CCSC team can always use new talent. Everyone who flys can submit his flight to OLC and contribute to the club ranking. The 2016 contest is already under way, so now is the time to start.
