### Minutes of the September 3, 2005 Board Meeting

Joe Jackson and Jim Hurst addressed the board on the subject of the boards recent decision to allow training in the K-21 and Grob. Their thinking is that some minimum number of flights should be set as a requirement to solo a particular glider by a student. One of the fears is that a student could rapidly transition between gliders without attaining sufficient experience in any one glider. Joe Jackson will discuss this issue among selected CFG's and recommend a specific course of action.

Motion to approve the minutes of the August meeting was made by Linda Murray, seconded by Dennis Fisher, motion approved unanimously.

Discussion of the gasoline situation, with evaluation of the feasibility of securing the gas tank. Dave Rawson to evaluate purchase and install a padlock on the gas tank if feasible. Keys to be placed on towplane key rings.

John Murray addressed the board on the issue of canopy maintenance. Brian Stoops to purchase canopy cleaner and soft cloths to be placed in the hangar for the purpose of cleaning the canopies after flying. The practice of covering the canopies with coarse canvas cloth to be curtailed.

## **Flying Treats**

Sweet Potato Casserole

Recipe from the McManus family

4 -5 large sweet potatoes, cooked, drained and mashed

1/3 - 1/2 stick butter

1 tsp. vanilla

1/4 c. sugar

2 eggs

Topping:

1/2 c. flour

1 c. brown sugar

1 c. chopped pecans

2/3 stick butter

Mix together sweet potatoes, butter, vanilla, sugar and eggs. Spread in 11x14 inch or 9x9 inch pan; set aside. Mix together topping ingredients until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Sprinkle over sweet potato mixture. Bake at 350 for 30 minutes, uncovered.
