CONGRATULATIONS CHRIS UHL - CFI-G

Friday was a good day for a Practical Test. Chris Uhl convinced Bob Miller to spend Friday conducting the Practical Test for the Certified Flight Instructor - Glider rating. Don Green joined the fun to fly the tow plane and Norm Leet helped with launching, retrieval, etc. Bob reports that it turned out to be a long day, but Chris did a good job with the whole test and was awarded CFI-G.

The next morning Chris was on duty with the Third Saturday Crew and ready to exercise his new privileges. Tom McDonald, Chief Flight Instructor, was at CCSC and did the honors of presenting Chris his new CCSC badge with the platinum name tape signifying his new status as a Certified Flight Instructor -

Tom also did the honors of presenting a new CCSC badge with blue name tape to Soren Adams to signify his successful completion of the Practical Test for his Private Pilot-Glider rating. Soren's achievement was reported in the July 18, 2017 Frequent Flyer at the conclusion of YEW, but the new badge was slow in being prepared. That was remedied Saturday by Soren's primary flight instructor and grandfather, Tom McDonald.

THIRD SATURDAY

Although the early forecast was not good Saturday turned out to be a great day for soaring with a total of 21 flights, 7 of which were guest rides. The WPAFB Airmen's Outdoor Recreation Program group of five airman arrived early and eager to fly. This is the second year that soaring at CCSC has been part of their outdoor recreation activities and the second time they have had good weather this



year so all the preliminaries were quickly completed and it was time to start flying. Tom McDonald provided a thorough preflight briefing and guided the airman in performing a careful preflight check of the glider.

HELP FINDING SOMEONE TO SWAP CREW DAY ASSIGNMENTS

A web-based process for facilitating swapping crew day assignments was announced in the 2/21/2017 Frequent Flyer along with instructions for using the system. This process is intended to help members find another member who will agree to swap crew duties for one specific set of dates. It is **not** for getting reassigned to a different crew for an indefinite period. Brian Stoops is the person who oversees crew assignments, so Brian is the one to whom you need to speak about a long term change.

Remember that **UOP 2.2 CREW MEMBER DUTIES** states: "All crew members are to report for duty at 9:30 AM and work until released by the Crew Chief. Each crew member is personally responsible for arranging for a qualified substitute in case of his or her absence. Scheduled crew members are expected to be present for each of their scheduled crew days regardless of flying conditions." This new process does not relieve any crew member from the responsibility for arranging for a qualified substitute and informing the crew chief; rather it is intended to help accomplish that task.
